This project will consist of a top navigation with a minimum of (6) pages and a minimum of 4 active social media icon buttons. The Navigation bar will feature either your logo or your choice of rounded edges or circle image of "you" with a drop down menu.

The page must meet the following criteria:

- All CSS is external
- Minimum of 3 Google Font API's
- Google Map API
- All pages that require scrolling include a scroll spy
- All navigation bars must be of a color (not black or default)
- All navigation bars must indicate if they are active, and possess the hover feature
- All buttons must include a glyphicon of font awesome icon
- All sites must start in the Git Bash terminal
- All sites must be internet accessible outside of GitHub
- All pages are titled with a title that reflects its content. Example: Nick Curlett-Home

- Home page includes a jumbotron and carousel with a maximum content of 4 images

 - o Images classes rounded, circle and thumbnail
 - Aspect ratio correct

 - Glyphicons and Font Awesome

- The page names will be as followed:
 - o Home
 - Must include a jumbotron and 4 image carousel
 - About
 - Compose as you deem, content must be relevant to page
 - o Portfolio
 - This page will reflect your entire web projects completed or not. Use media object as your layout with a working link to your projects (button) or image. The image must reflect your project and a caption instructing how to go to your project.
 - Gallery
 - Your theme, with captions, a minimum of 12 images. Use thumb nails and 4 images across. The page heading will be separated from the images by a colored horizontal rule.
 - Destination images a minimum of 800px in width and aspect ratio correct
 - (Your Choice Topic)
 - A soapbox topic: Some form of social aware that is not defamatory to anyone, person or thing.
 - Contact
 - A map to Launchcode or the place pertaining to the relevant content of your website
 - Contact information
 - An image of you or the relevant logo of the map destination
